

## Players- PNA Soccer Academy agreement

*Prior to participating in the PNA Soccer Academy, players and their parents or guardians are required to read and complete the following Player-PNA Soccer Academy agreement. This agreement outlines the general conditions governing a player's participation within the PNA Soccer Academy:*

### Player will:

1. Honor all commitments required by the PNA Soccer Academy.
2. Remain with the PNA Soccer Academy and not transfer to another club during this seasonal year unless extenuating circumstances exist (ex. Relocation, irreconcilable differences with coach or organization) which must be documented.
3. Notify their director if a member of another club coaching staff approaches them for purpose of recruitment.
4. Not attend any other coaching training session or play for any other soccer organization without written permission or approval from his/her director. High School soccer and IYSA ODP are excepted.
5. Attend all PNA Soccer Academy training and games as required. It's my understanding that players not attending or providing insufficient cause and notice for their absence may forfeit their place within PNA Soccer Academy.
6. Represent the PNA Soccer Academy with values and principles of the highest standard both on and off the field.
7. Maintain and wear all training and game apparel. I do understand that I am required to wear official PNA Soccer Academy apparel at all sessions.
8. Fulfill all academic responsibilities required of them. I realize that PNA Soccer Academy training, games and travel are not an excuse for missing or not fulfilling any academic responsibilities expected of me.
9. Refrain from using foul language, alcohol, drugs, nicotine or anything in that sense that degrades my condition of an athlete.
10. Treat all teammates, opponents, officials and coaches with courtesy, respect and good sportsmanship.
11. Address any problem with a teammate, coach or club official by communicating directly to that individual aware of players U11 and above, not parents, are responsible for that.
12. Guide his/her behavior by common sense principles and ethics which make all of us proud of being athletes.
